Please read the following for guest pass application instructions.

GUEST PASS INSTRUCTIONS

1. Fill out the "SHS Student Information" section and have it signed by a parent or guardian.
2. Have your guest fill out the "Guest Information" section and attach a copy of their ASB card or Driver's license, based on the appropriate criteria.
3. Have your guest obtain an administrator's signature and attach their administrator's business card.
4. Bring your paperwork to Skyline and find a Skyline administrator to sign the guest pass form at the bottom. If an administrator is not available, leave the form at the front desk in the main office and pick it up after an administrator has signed it.
5. Turn in your completed guest pass form when you purchase your tickets.

Students who are bringing a guest to the Skyline High School PROM must abide by the following regulations:

1. A completed guest pass form must be submitted when tickets are purchased.
2. Students and their guest must follow all dance policy rules and regulations (see back).
3. Students must enter and leave the dance with their guest.
4. **Guests must provide a photocopy of student photo ID card from their high school.**
5. **Guests who do not attend high school must provide a photocopy of their photo ID (i.e. driver's license) and must be 20 years of age or younger.**
6. Skyline High School students are responsible for the behavior of their guests.
7. If you or your guest is asked to leave, both parties must leave.
8. No re-entry is allowed.

DANCE POLICY

- A. **All students must have picture ID to enter.** Accepted forms of ID are an ASB card, driver’s license or passport.
- B. **Freak dancing is not allowed.** Students may be removed from the dance without a refund for this behavior. Freak dancing is defined as any dancing that is found to be “sexually suggestive in any way,” and is inappropriate for school. Think: would you want to see your mother or father doing **THAT?** If the answer is no, or “EWW!”, then don’t dance that way! Examples include but are not limited to: inappropriate back-to-front dancing, excessive displays of affection or mosh pit style dancing.
- C. **Appropriate attire required.** Any student who is dressed inappropriately will be asked to change or be removed from the dance without a refund.
- D. **Absolutely NO drugs or alcohol of any kind.** Neither on your person or currently under the influence.

NOTE: Administration reserves the right to determine what is appropriate.
